

Enrolment Guidelines

Admissions Guidelines Rangi Ruru Girls' School

1. Admissions decisions at Rangi Ruru Girls' School (the School) are made by the Principal, in consultation with the Assistant Principal – Curriculum, relevant Year Level Deans and other relevant staff at the School.
2. Admissions procedures will fully support the values of the School.
3. The School will ensure it operates effective, fair and equitable application and enrolment procedures for students and their families who submit an application to the School.
4. The School will provide appropriate application, assessment and monitoring strategies to ensure that we can provide fully for the learning needs of selected students.
5. When making offers of a place, the School may take into consideration the applicant's affiliation with it through, but not limited to siblings of current or past students, students whose mother or grandmothers attended Rangi Ruru Girl' School, former students who are re-enrolling, students of staff.
6. The School offers places for students with learning differences. These places are limited and allocated following a review of education assessments provided by the family/previous school and any further assessment required by the School taking into account whether it is reasonable for the School to provide services and facilities in the particular circumstances.
7. The School offers places for students for whom English is a second language with preference given to students who are proficient in English and for whom the English language is spoken in the home.
8. Parents/Guardians must provide a full and open declaration of any issues which may impact on the student's learning. Failure to do so may result in the withdrawal of the student's place at the School or the withdrawal of an offer of place.
9. The School will abide by all appropriate New Zealand enrolment legislation.
10. The School has agreed to observe and be bound by the Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021 (the Code).
